Introduction

Airports Vanuatu Ltd prepares a monthly update to stakeholders, reporting past statistical performance and future seat capacity forecasts for Bauerfield International Airport (VLI). The purpose of the update is to enable stakeholders to be informed and have insights into the airport's operating statistics.

Headlines

- Port Vila Bauerfield International Airport continues to break records
 - In the year to Jun18, 497,000 passengers were processed, up 11% on the previous year
 - Growth has been driven by both more aircraft movements and higher load factors
- International seat capacity in six months time, in Jan19, is forecast to be 15% up on Jan18 (see next page).

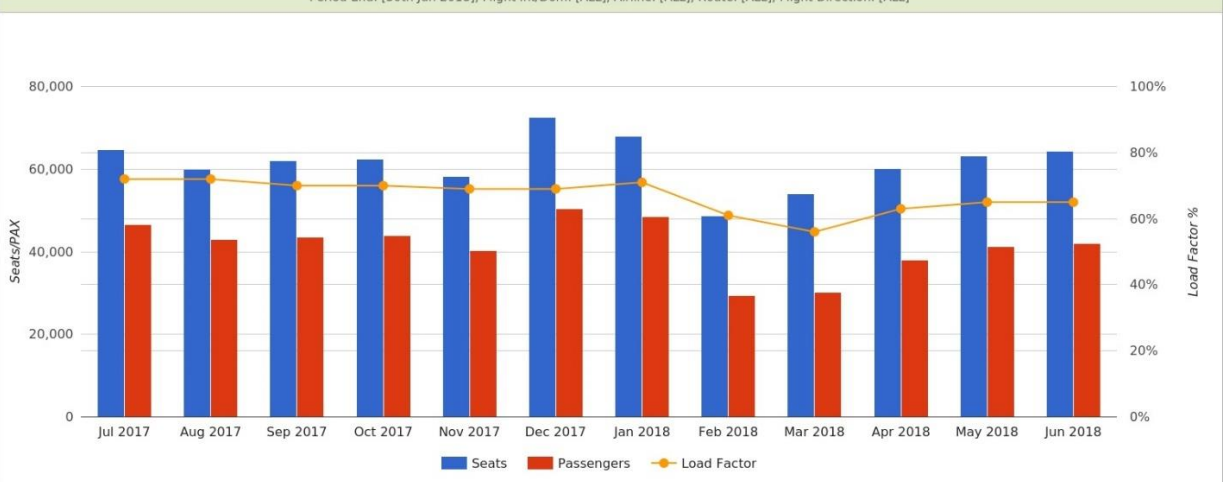

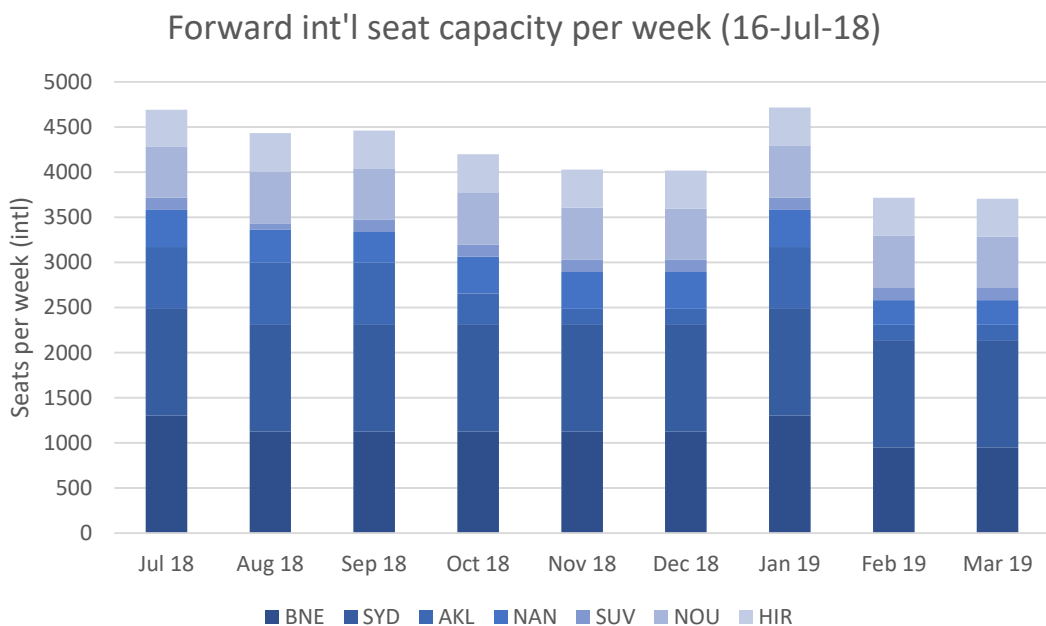

VLI Future international seat capacity

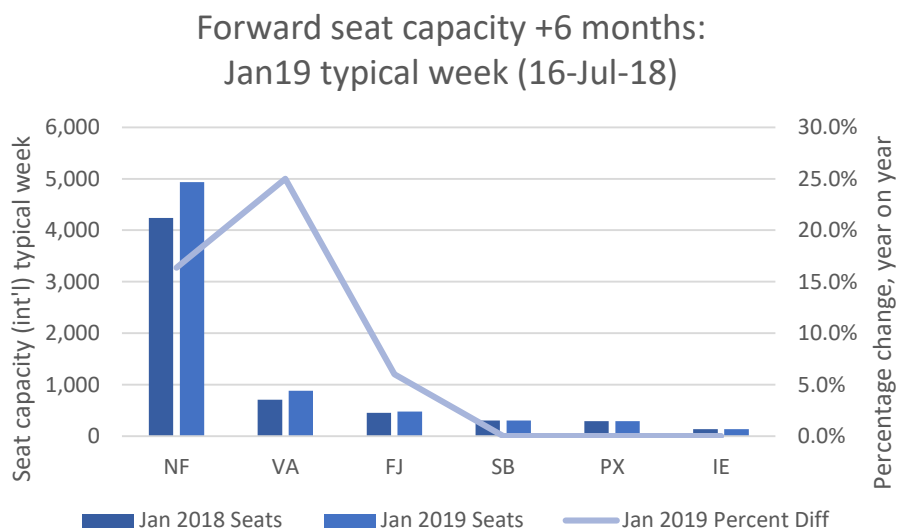
International seat capacity is forecast to grow year on year for the coming Northern Winter scheduling period.



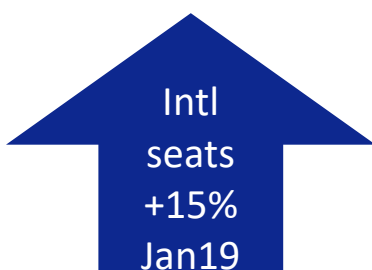
